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Emily Tianru Jin, age 11, from Lexington MA, started piano lessons at the New England Conservatory (NEC) Preparatory School at age 5. An award-winner at several competitions, Emily has performed in public at NEC, Groton Hill Music Center, Shalin Liu Performance Center in Rockport MA, and the Eastman School of Music. She studies piano with Angel Ramón Rivera and Xu Guo, and has previously studied with Yutong Sun and Motti Fang-Bentov.

Ian Lin, a native Rhode Islander from South Kingstown, is a pianist, composer, and violinist. He is the son of Christine Liu and University of Rhode Island professor Bing-Xuan Lin. Ian is known for his precocious talent and success in international music competitions from an early age. A former student of Tanya Schwartzman and Natalie Zhu, Ian currently studies piano with Jonathan Bass and Wei-Yi Yang.

Eliot Arolovitch, a senior at Brookline High School outside Boston, has studied classical piano with Ian Lindsey since the age of six. He is currently a member of the A. Ramon Rivera Senior Piano Seminar at the New England Conservatory Preparatory School. After winning first prize in the Boston Symphony Orchestra 2025-2026 Concerto Competition, Eliot was invited to perform the first movement of Prokofiev's Piano Concerto No. 2 with the BSO. The performance took place in March 2026.
